Working Party Aims

The EAP Tracking Project Working Party met on the 22nd January 2010 at Sheffield Hallam University to have an update on progress and to clarify future plans. It was agreed that the Working Party aims are as follows:

- 1) to share projects in progress: research questions, project outlines, ethics documentation; relevant literature, data collection tools, ways of approaching data analysis and presentation
- 2) to devise and publicise a resource bank which will provide guidelines, encouragement and support for members of the group and others undertaking tracking research
- 3) to identify opportunities for collaborative tracking projects between institutions
- 4) to organise a PIM on June 25th 2011 at the University of Kent: present papers, invite others who have done similar work, run workshops
- 5) to produce a BALEAP publication as a result of the EAP Tracking PIM
